## **URGENT – PLEASE READ IMMEDIATELY – THINGS ARE NOW SERIOUS**

You are being asked by your colleagues in Parliament to vote on whether to :-

- Delay our exit from the EU, and/or
- To hold another referendum, and/or
- To revoke Article 50 altogether, and/or
- To vote for Mrs May's surrender document named 'the Withdrawal Agreement'
- Or to let the law take its course and for the UK to exit on 29 March 2019 with or without any overarching agreement.

## I am writing to you with a very clear message.

The UK must leave the EU on 29 March 2019, as defined in the Article 50 notification which Parliament voted for by 5 to 1 in 2017. It must now do so on WTO terms, as Mrs May's 'deal' is not leaving in any normal sense.

I'm sorry, but I do not care about your views about EU membership. Neither do I care what you think of the Government's disastrous handling of the Brexit negotiations.

We had an EU Referendum, approved by Parliament. You gave the decision to the people and we took it. We did NOT vote on the basis of one kind of exit deal or another. We voted to leave. Full stop.

I urge you to consider your position and your responsibilities. Delaying Brexit will have severe consequences.

## If you do not allow Brexit to proceed on WTO terms on 29 March :-

- 1. I will never vote for you again, nor will many of my friends or family
- 2. All faith in democracy on which you relied to be voted into Parliament will be lost
- 3. You will be responsible for a catastrophic breakdown in the social order in our country

Although a mutually beneficial deal is preferable it's not attainable and there is nothing to fear from no deal and trading on global WTO terms as most nations do.

Exiting the EU on 29 March overrides everything. No matter what challenges we will surmount them. Most importantly our democracy will be intact and we will quickly thrive as a nation.
